**Archibald Miller**

Archibald farmed in the 97th district of Rush County. He built a brick house at Neffs Corner next to his own log home. This is the same brick house in which his grandsons, Harry and Angus, were raised by family friend, Emma Stevens, after the death of their parents. The house was still standing in 1981 according to Christina MILLER Leaman as reported in her family history, BEGINNINGS.

According to "The Bicentennial History of Rush County, Indiana" issued in 1921, Archibald owned 343 acres of land in Rush County and was a member of the United Brethren Church of Andersonville.

In the 1870 census, a John Stewart age 15 born in New York is living with the Archibald Miller family. Most liking John is an orphan train rider.

**Charles S. Miller**

The Rush County History book of 1888 states that Charles was a prominent farmer in Richland Township. "Besides considerable property which he has given his children, he is the owner of a fine farm of 250 acres, about half of which is in cultivation. It is fitted up with good fences and buildings and is a very desirable location."

Charles was a Republican and held the office of Justice of the Peace two terms of four years each.

Sarah's Will follows:

I, Sarah MILLER, a resident of Richland Township, Rush County, Indiana, being of sound mind and disposing memory and being desirous of disposing of all my estate consisting of both real and personal property do make, ordain and publish this instrument as and for my last will and testament. Item 1.. I hereby will that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of my personal property as soon as possible after my decease. Item 2.. I hereby devise and bequeath all my property of every kind whatsoever both real and personal which may remain after the payments of my debts and funeral expenses, and which I own at my decease, to my dearly beloved friend, Emma R. Stevens, to have and to hold as her own absolutely. Item 3.. I hereby appoint said Emma R. Stevens executor of this my last will and testament but direct that if she will comply with the provisions of Item 1 of this will by paying all my just debts and funeral expenses then I authorize here to take possession of all of my said property as her own without giving any bond, filing any inventory or qualifying in any way as such executor.

In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 12th day of July, 1907.

**Peter Miller**

According to the Muster and Descriptive Roll for Company E, 79th Reg, Illinois volunteers, at age 27 Peter was 5' 8" tall with dark hair, blue eyes and a dark complexion. According to his pension record he was captured during the battle of Stone River Dec. 31, '62 to Jan. 3, '63. He spent time at Camp Chase in Ohio as a paroled prisoner. He was transferred to the V. R. C. by War Dept. General Order #24 on Jan. 16, 1864. Mustered Out June 12, 1865.

I am in possession of several letters written by Peter to his parents and sisters during the Civil War.

Peter was married 1st to Philena Points in Franklin County, Indiana on Dec. 16, 1858. That marriage produced on child, Charley, born September 7, 1859. Charley and Philena are living with her father in Franklin County, Indiana in the 1860 census. Peter is not listed there. A divorce decree was finalized in Chicago, Illinois on May 8, 1865.

Peter was married 2nd to Harriet Wison in Clark County, Illinois on January 20, 1866.

Additional confirmation that this Peter married Harriet Wilson in Clark County, Illinois 20 Jan 1866 is a mortgage issued by Peter and Harriet MILLER to Sarah MILLER of Rush county, Indiana.

**Eliphalet Barber Miller**

On July 21, 1862, he enlisted for the Union and was an honored veteran of the Civil War. He went to the front as a private in C Company 68th Regiment, Indiana Volunteer Infantry. He was discharged three years later as a sergeant of C Company on June 25, 1865 in Nashville, Tennessee.

After the war he went to Illinois where he devoted his attention to farming.

Around 1883 , he and his family returned to Rush County, Indiana,purchasing 147 acres of land which he farmed until his death.
